Instagram

As far as social platforms go, few can actually rival the popularity of Instagram. The reason behind this is the fact that it is so easy to make a career out of just posting photos. Anyone can become a social entrepreneur on this platform, which is what sets it apart from most any other traffic source out there.

Nobody will believe you outright anyway, and it's not like you're stealing from people's wallets. All that you're doing is creating a topical focus point where people can discuss certain things.

Again, the more controversial the better, but it always needs to be set in the realm of possibility. This basically means that you cannot just go “I need help I was kidnapped by aliens and am stuck in their spaceship how do I escape do I pick up the red cube or the blue triangle?”. This will never get you more than a few replies because you’re obviously just fishing for attention. People tend to ignore these types of questions/topics.

No, if you really want to attract more and more attention all that you really need to do is you need to keep your question serious, realistic while also either being obviously in the right or choosing the worst decision ever and trying to justify yourself enough to stir up people that they can’t help but defend their own opinions in the replies.

So, you can either go for the obvious “I am in danger at the moment, I need to know how to make a living because I am now homeless, how can I get a job as a high school dropout?” or you can be a bit more spicy and go for something like “My son is 17 and yet he doesn’t have a job yet. Should I threaten to throw him out if he doesn’t or should I make him pay rent so he has to get a job?”.

It’s not the most graceful job ever, but you will be making a ton of money by the end of the day, and you will not be hurting anyone or anything. It’s just simple playful banter made to attract as much attention as possible. Everybody knows that this is fake most of the time, so everybody’s just having fun discussing and debating the choices they can take from these scenarios. Think of all of this as a roleplaying game. You’re providing the character with a specific dilemma and you’re looking for solutions while getting paid. It’s a win-win for everybody involved, really.

Blogging for Traffic

This is not a specific platform, we know, but it is one of the most effective ways of making money nowadays without having to spend any money whatsoever to get into the business. Literally all that you really need to do in order to get started is:

- a) Have a good grasp of the language that you're writing in
- b) Be creative and insightful
- c) Know how to attract the attention of strangers

This is literally it. If you've got all three of those boxes checked out then you shouldn't be having any trouble making a living off of blogging. career is to be consistent, which means that you need to create an internet persona that people can understand and agree with.

So, for example, you cannot just say whatever people want you to say. You cannot just give every movie a 10/10 because by doing so you'll soon lose credibility. If you wish to make a living off of blogging you'll need to be consistent and make people resonate with your writing. This is quite difficult, yes, but not impossible. Making a career out of this will literally open up a ton of pathways though for the near future so be sure to work your hardest if you're planning on getting into this medium.
